## How long do my sensors last?

The module boards and sensor boards should last indefinitely barring damage.

pH sensor probes have a lifespan of two years and as such will need to be replaced.

Dissolved oxygen sensor probes have a lifespan of two years and require reconditioning every 3-6 months . They will also need to be replaced after their two year lifespan.

Electrical conductivity probes, temperature probes, and weather instrumentation will last indefinitely unless they are damaged.
